## HONORARY MEMBER PETITIONS READY

Blanks for petition of Nomination of Honorary members to the Order, may be had by writing to Secretary. The constitution states, in Section 4. Honorary Membership.

1. Any registered Scouter is eligible for Honorary Membership.
2. Any group of five Active Golden Suns may nominate one person for Honorary membership.
3. The name of the Scouter nominated for honorary membership, must be transmitted to the Secretary of the Order, not later than August 1st.
4. Election will be by two-thirds vote of the Cabinet.
5. Election of Honorary members shall be on the basis of outstanding contrubutions to Scouting.
6. Elected Honorary members need not go through the entire initiation ceremony, but should attend the final campfire ceremony. "
