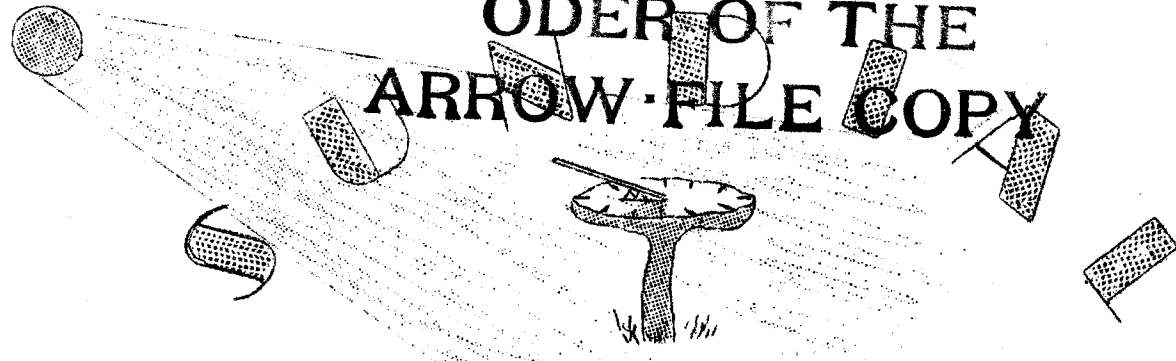


ORDER OF THE GOLDEN SUN:
