NEXT LODGE MEETING

The next lodge meeting is at 2:30 PM, on Sunday November 28, 1954, at the High School Auditorium in Nebraska City. DUES

With the Lodge split, our council lodge was left high and dry without a cent in the till. Because the organization does have expenses, the Tribal Council met and decided the only way to pay our way was to charge members dues. Dues for the present year are payable immediately if not sooner, and you can mail them in or pay them up at the next meeting. In order for you to stay an active member, you'll have to pay a dollar each year for dues. All identification cards (the red and white ones) are now outdated, and you will get a new one when you pay your dues. The lodge is in the red now, so pay your dues, and help everyone out of a hole.

A NAME FOR THE LODGE

One of the points of dispute over the split of the lodge this fall was what would happen to the name "Golden Sun". Because of this dispute, a motion was passed at the last pow-wow to the affect that each of the new lodges should adopt a new name in an Indian language or dialect of their respective areas meaning Golden Sun. Just what this motion means is that technically the lodge has no name because at present the name Golden Sun has been put in the History books, and we have to find an Indian name meaning the same thing. We're supposed to do this as soon as possible.

One of the important items of business at the next meeting of the Lodge at Nebraska City will be the adopting of a new name, and all of you Indian Lore Experts have a chance to heop us here. Why don't you search your knowledge, and find us a name. Then bring it to the next meeting because we're going to have to find one.
