CAMPING FOR 1500

This year the Cornhusker Council would like to see 75% of the registered Scouts and Explorers in the Council take advantage of the summer camp experiences. This means that they would like to have 1500 Scouts and Explorers in one camp or another. The Order of the Arrow is doing the job of promoting the summer camp to the boys in the troops in the Council. To do this, a camp promotion program has been developed to present to all the units within the area of our lodge, and now it's up to all the OA men to really get behind this project and push summer camp.

How can you help? You can help by working with the OA camp promotion teams that have been organized in each district. These teams visit the troops and put on the camp promotion program consisting of slides with script, a question and answer period, and any other skits, demonstrations, or such gimmicks that the teams want to use. The idea is to show the troops what is available to them for summer camp, and to get the kids all fired up to go to camp. Your district representative has all the details. You can get in touch with him, or you can talk to the city spark plugs, who know quite a bit about this project.

Another big way to promote camp is just to talk it up. Tell the boys in your troop or post about the great times you had at camp, tell about all the fun you had; this is the way to get the younger Scouts hep on camp, and it is the thing that's the easiest for most Suns to do. The thing to remember is that our organization exists for the purpose of doing service to Scouting, and this is one of our big services.
