The nicest thing about the new circle is that it will have a raised stage, and because of this plan, the ceremonies will be a lot more effective. The committee has Charles Adams for chairman, and consists of F. G. Adams, Joe Cook, John Donaldson, Roger Corn, and Leland Liming.
