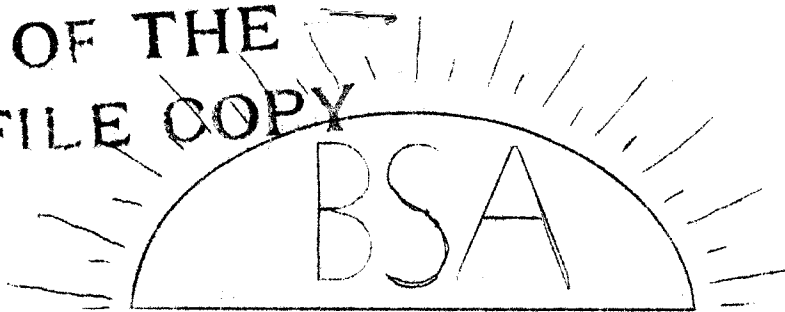

### TAPPING TEAMS TO BE ANNOUNCED
