MONEY! MONEY! MONEY!

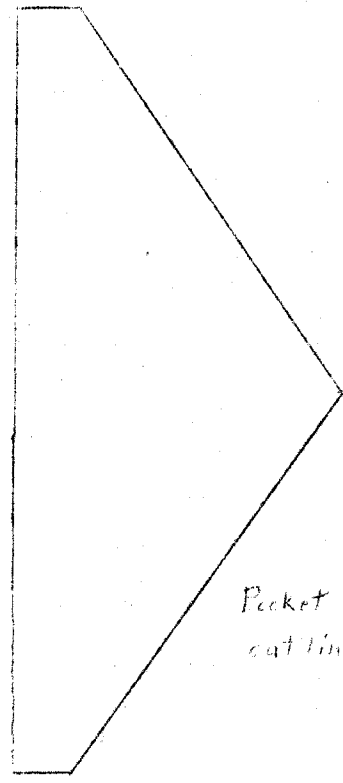
What expenses does the lodge have? What sources of income? To find out read page four. The report consists of all spendings, earnings, etc. If you have any questions as to what the different items are please contact us at the office and we will be glad to inform you how and what makes the lodge tick.

Much money is spent on items such as postage. To send out one SUNDIAL it costs from two to four dollars. (the usual cost is between one and 1 1/2 cent per piece of mail.) Any other mail such as that sent to committee members or to mail dues cards add up to not less than two cents per piece. Sometimes it costs as much as twenty cents to mail a sash or book. Many of you probably don't really know what it costs to put on the fall initiation so you will find a separate item dealing with the initiation. Out of every \$6.50 that we collected for the Pow Wow this year one dollar was turned in as dues for the candidates. For the rest of the information read page 4 of this issue.
