

1957 CAMPING SEASON  
BEGINS JUNE 16

CORNHUSKER COUNCIL B.S.A. BEGINS THEIR 1957 SEASON OF SCOUT CAMPING ON JUNE 16 WITH THE OPENING OF TWO CAMPS.

THE RESERVATION AT HUMBOLDT AND CAMP MINIS KUYA. THE RESERVATION, IS BEGINNING ITS SECOND SEASON AS A FULL SUMMER CAMP. THREE YEARS AGO IT WAS RUN FOR ONLY TWO WEEKS.

IT OFFERS OPEN AIR COOKING,-- CHARCOAL--GOOD FOOD (IF PREPARED CORRECTLY)--A PX OR CANTEEN, SCOUT-CRAFT OPPORTUNITIES ON YOUR OWN WITH SUGGESTIONS MADE BY A COUNSELOR. THE SWIMMING WILL AGAIN BE IN THE LAKE AS A POOL HAS NOT YET BEEN INSTALLED. HORSEBACK RIDING WILL BE AN EXTRA FEATURED ONLY AT THE RESERVATION. THE RESERVATION WILL BE OPEN AT LEAST 8 WEEKS--FROM JUNE 16 TO AUGUST 10.

MINIS KUYA ALSO OFFERS THE OPEN AIR COOKING AND GOOD FOOD, THE CANTEEN, SCOUTCRAFT OPPORTUNITIES UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF AN ABLE-BODIED SCOUT. SWIMMING WILL BE AT THE POOL LOCATED ON THE CAMP-SITE. THE LENGTH OF THE CAMP IS JUNE 16-JULY 6.

BOTH CAMPS OFFER FULL EVENING PROGRAMING WITH SEVERAL FULL-CAMP CAMPFIRE, A TROOP CAMPFIRE, AND AN EVENING FOR ORDER OF THE ARROW CEREMONIES.

REGISTRATION FOR THE CAMPS WILL PROBABLY BEGIN AT 1:00 OR 1:30 P.M. SUNDAY AFTERNOON AND CHECK-OUT WILL BE MADE AFTER THE NOON MEAL ON SATURDAY.

CAMP COSTS FOR THIS YEAR WILL BE ON THE SAME BASIS AS IN THE PAST.

AT HUMBOLDT, THE COST WILL BE \$13.50 WITH \$7 OF THIS BEING A EARLY REGISTRATION FEE. CAMP MINIS KUYA COSTS WILL ALSO BE WORKED THE SAME WAY. THE TOTAL FEE IS \$15.00 WITH A EARLY REGISTRATION FEE OF \$7.50.

ORDER OF THE ARROW  
REQUIREMENTS ANNOUNCED  
FOR CANDIDATES

THIS ISSUE IS THE ONLY ONE DURING THE YEAR THAT WILL CONTAIN THE LIST OF REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE ORDER OF THE ARROW.

THE CANDIDATE MUST BE A SCOUT OR EXPLORER IN GOOD STANDING AND HAVING SHOWN ABOVE NORMAL QUALITIES OF LEADERSHIP. HE MUST HAVE AT LEAST 15 DAYS AND NIGHTS OF CAMPING WITH NO MORE THAN 7 BEING IN A LONG TERM (SUMMER) CAMP. THE SCOUT MUST HOLD ANY FOUR OF THESE SEVEN MERIT BADGES: CAMPING, COOKING, NATURE, PIONEERING, SWIMMING, OR ANY THREE OF THE ABOVE, ONE OF THEM BEING CAMPING, COOKING, OR PIONEERING, AND ONE OF THE FOLLOWING: CITIZENSHIP IN THE HOME, CITIZENSHIP IN THE NATION, CITIZENSHIP IN THE COMMUNITY, OR WORLD BROTHERHOOD.

REQUIREMENTS FOR HONORARIES (SCOUTERS) ARE THAT HE HAS 15 DAYS AND NIGHTS OF CAMPING NO MORE THAN 7 BEING AT A LONG TERM CAMP, AND THAT HE BE ELECTED BY THE TROOP OR POST COMMITTEE.

8 THE UNIT LEADERS HAVE ALREADY RECEIVED A COMPLETE COPY OF THE REQUIREMENTS, HISTORY, AND AN APPLICATION BLANK FOR THE ORDER OF THE ARROW. IF YOU HAVE ANYONE IN YOUR UNIT WHO IS QUALIFIED PLEASE TALK IT OVER WITH THE UNIT LEADER AND OFFER YOUR HELP IN THE ELECTION AND APPLICATION FORM. THE MORE BOYS AND SCOUTERS THAT WE INITIATE, THE STRONGER OUR ORGANIZATION WILL BE.

ARE REPEATED

BREECHCLOT-14" BY 16", TWO SIDES, A CONNECTING PIECE, ALL OF BLACK MATERIAL. THIS PIECE IS TRIMMED AROUND THE EDGE WITH 1/2" YELLOW TRIM. A TWO INCH YELLOW SUN (1/2 POINTED) IS LOCATED 2" FROM EACH EDGE IN THE LOWER RIGHT HAND CORNER. DARK COLORED SWIM SUITS MAY BE WORN UNDER THE BREECHCLOT, BUT THIS IS NOT RECOMMENDED (CONTINUED ON PAGE 3 OF THIS ISSUE)
