Headdress--To be worn only according
to rank in the lodge, Braves-two feathers,
Warriors-three feathers, Chiefs-full
headdresses when available.

At camp ceremonies the OA represen-
tative will have the choice of who wears
the headdresses. Headdresses at camp
will be worn according to part played.

Bells--Bells may be purchased at any
Scout store but it is suggested that
only runners and sachems wear them at
initiations. Camp representatives will
have final approval of bell wearing for
tapping ceremonies.
