T.C. MINUTES

On Sunday, November 3, a Tribal Council meeting was held at the Boy Scout Office, 220 No. 11th, Lincoln, Nebraska. Members present were: Robert Porter, Don Epp, Bruce Abernathy, Ken Teapero, Dennis Karnopp, Budd Davidson, Roger Dodson, Gene Leck, Allen Elliott, Tom Barrett, Gary Nelson, Lyle Ullstrom, and Darrell Shepard.

Reports given by the committee chairmen present, indicated that the lodge was progressing fairly well this fall.

A report by Don Epp indicated that we had not acted on the fall grassing of the circle quickly enough. The next step toward the final circle grassing will be next spring when a detail of Ordeal members will plant buffalo grass in the center. This will be immediately following the spring powwow.

Our lodge's winter event will be held on the 28th of December, 1957. More details will be sent out later concerning this event.

It was decided by the Tribal Council that all incomplete lodge application blanks would be returned to the leader submitting them. Previously it had

been the lodge's practice to accept these blanks, however, because of current difficulties caused by this practice, it was decided to discontinue this policy.
