

## COSTUMES

For the benefit of all new Ordeal members, and other new lodge transfers, the specifications for lodge costumes are as follows:

### Breechcloth:

Made of black cloth, 10 to 12 inches wide, and 12 to 16 inches long, per panel. A  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch yellow strip of cloth is to run around the outside edge of the panels. A yellow sun, 3 inches in diameter, with 12 points is to be located 2 inches from either edge of the lower right hand corner. Your personal lodge totem (your Indian name.) is to go in the upper left hand corner.

### Lanyard:

2 eagle claws attractively mounted in a pouch containing your own medicine, worn about the neck at all scouting functions. The first claw is obtained immediately after initiation, and the second, one year from then.

### Coups:

To be worn on the lanyard.  
Round-----1 for each year at camp after initiation.  
Square-----1 for each year on camp staff after initiation.  
Red, White, & Blue-----for service in the armed forces after initiation.

### Headresses:

To be worn only according to lodge rank, or initiation assignment.  
Braves-----2 feathers  
Warriors-----3 feathers  
Chiefs-----full headresses

### Sash:

Brotherhood or Ordeal, according to

lodge standing, to be worn at all ceremonies.

### Bells:

Bells may be worn only by runners, sachems, and chiefs at the initiations. Camp representatives will have the final approval for bell wearing at calling out ceremonies. Bells may be purchased at any scout distributor.
