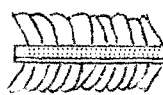

POW WOW

The Spring Pow Wow of the Golden Sun Lodge will be held at Camp Minis Kuya. It will start on Friday 9 May 1958 at 4:00 P.M. and will end around 10:00 A.M. on Sunday 11 May 1958. It would be a great help to the committees and to the Pow Wow director if all of the members that can would arrive as soon as possible on Friday.

This Spring the Pow Wow will be conducted in a slightly different manner than it has been in the past. One of the Tribal Council members, Dennis Karnopp, will be the Director. His word is the law. All questions will be answered by the Pow Wow director so that we will not have some of the confusion that has been experienced in the past.

I COSTUMES

1. No one may be near the candidates without an Indian costume on.
2. No jeans or shirts may be worn with Indian costumes.
3. Costume assignments;
Chiefs--as set up in the O.A. Manual
Senior Sachem--White Water-- Black Smoke-----war bonnet, necklace or choaker, arm bands, vest, breechclot, leggings, and moccasins.
Sachem Assistants---feather roach, necklace or choaker, breechclot, leggings, and moccasins.
Runners, Torchmen, and Firemen---fluff roach, breechclot, and moccasins.
Canoe Paddlers, Drummers and Medicine Men--any reasonable costume.
4. Runners must wear bells. Others may wear bells. Only chiefs may wear bells during Ordeal Ceremony.

II JOBS

1. Any one not willing to do his job cheerfully will be asked to leave.
2. No one may be near the candidates unless he is assigned there.
3. No conversation is to be carried on near the candidates. The only talking is to be necessary orders and the parts in the Ritual.
4. No one is to haze the candidates in any way.
