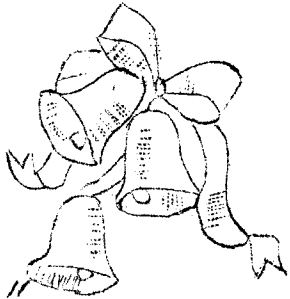

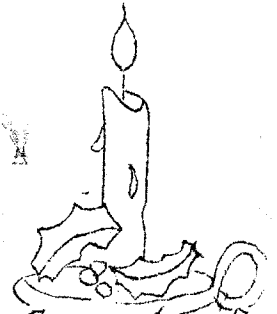

Three others were tapped out at the Philmont Scout Ranch. The remaining eight Scouts were tapped out elsewhere.
