"SEE EVERYBODY AT THE WINTER EVENT"

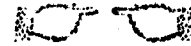


## Have You Heard?

THE PURPOSE OF CHAPTERS, AS SUGGESTED BY THE NATIONAL COMMITTEE, IS TO PROVIDE A BETTER MEANS OF CARRYING THE PROGRAM OF THE LODGE DOWN TO THE INDIVIDUAL MEMBER. THUS CHAPTERS ARE ORGANIZED IN THOSE LODGES WHICH HAVE A LARGE ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF FIXING RESPONSIBILITY, THE CHAPTER MAINTAINS CERTAIN OFFICERS, AS CHIEF, VICE CHIEF, SECRETARY, AND ADVISOR. EACH INDIVIDUAL MEMBER OF HIS CHAPTER AND BRING BACK TO THESE MEMBERS THE POLICIES, GOALS AND PROJECTS OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL.
