

Proposed Constitution of the Golden Sun Lodge
Order of the Arrow
Cornhusker Council
Boy Scouts of America

This organization shall be known as the Golden Sun Lodge of the Order of the Arrow, Boy Scouts of America.

It shall be the purpose of this organization to recognize the outstanding camper and, through cheerful service, to encourage further development in camping, Scouting, leadership, and pursuance of the Scout Oath and Law.

ARTICLE I - Administration

Section 1 - The administrative powers of the Lodge shall be vested in a Tribal Council consisting of the Lodge officers, Chapter Chief, and Assistant Chapter Chief.

Section 2 - Lodge officers shall consist of:

Assistant Lodge Chief	Elected
Lodge Secretary	Elected
Lodge Treasurer	Elected
Lodge Advisor	Elected

Section 3 - Chapters

A) The administrative powers of each chapter shall be vested in the chapter officers.

B) Chapter officers shall consist of:

Chapter Chief of the Fire	District Executive
Chapter Chief	Elected
Assistant Chapter Chief	Elected
Chapter Secretary	Elected
Chapter Advisor	Appointed

ARTICLE II - Legislation

Section 1 - A) The legislative power of the Lodge shall be vested in a Pow-Wow of the members of the lodge.

B) Each active boy Brotherhood member shall be entitled to one vote on all matters of legislation.

C) A majority vote of the Pow-Wow shall be required to pass all legislation except that of amending the constitution.

D) The Tribal Council of the Lodge shall have the power to enact legislation between the Pow-Wows.

Section 2 - Chapters

A) The legislative power of the chapter shall be vested in a Pow-Wow of the members of the chapter.

B) All chapter rules and legislation shall conform to the Lodge Constitution, By-Laws, and legislation.
