EIGHT ONE POT MEALS

These eight "in a pot" meals will make six servings to fill five people or four hungry Arrowmen.

IN A POT, brown $1\frac{1}{2}$ lbs. of hamburger. Add 1 or 2 chopped onions and $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 chopped green pepper (or their equivalent in dehydrated form); 1 can undiluted condensed tomato soup. Salt and pepper to taste.

FOR:

Yum-Yums
Camper's Spaghetti
Spanish Rice
Macaroni Beef
Hunter's stew
Chili
Squaw Corn
Hungarian Hot Pot

ADD:

$\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. chili powder and put on or between buns.
Two No. 2 cans of spaghetti.
1 small package precooked rice.
 $\frac{1}{2}$ lb. package macaroni (cooked separately).
2 cans vegetable soup.
2 no. 2 cans red beans and chili powder.
1 large can corn and $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. diced cheese.
2 cans baked beans.

For eight to ten Scouts, just double the recipe. These meals are exceptionally easy and wholesome for Scout camping trips.
