We have opened the year with a highly successful Fall Pow Wow. We inducted over 100 new members and brought nearly 50 into the Brotherhood membership. Of course, we cannot forget our newly inducted Vigil Honor member, Bob Sack.

Believe it or not, plans are already being made for the 1965 Fall Pow Wow.

Plans have been made to introduce something new into the lodge schedule. The Tribal Council has made arrangements to hold an officer training course at the Congress Inn in Lincoln during the latter part of October. I personally feel that this will be an investment in the future, for many of our young officers and committee chairman will be preparing themselves to hold key positions in the Order.

The annual Winter Event has been scheduled for December 19, 1964, at the First Plymouth Congregational Church in Lincoln. I have been informed that this event will include all of the things which have been so well like in the past, plus many new and interesting sidelights.

Each year the Order holds a Spring Pow Wow.....this year will be no exception. The event has been set up for the middle of April. Among other things I am sure that those members who attend this event will receive a special patch. Last year's event was an overwhelming success and I am sure that the same will be said for the 1965 Spring Pow Wow.

The annual Fall Pow Wow will be held the third weekend in August at Minis Kuya.

The week following the Pow Wow will indeed be the climax of the year. At that time the Fiftieth Anniversary National Order of the Arrow Conference will be held at the University of Indiana, Bloomington, Indiana.

It has been proposed that the lodge send approximately forty members to this event by chartered bus. This proposition is being considered at the present time, and if sufficient interest is shown, I am sure that this dream of the Tribal Council will become reality.

It is my only hope as Lodge Chief that this, the Fiftieth year of our order, will be the most successful in our history.
