Precut lodge totums, breechclothes, leggings, headdresses, etc., may be purchased in kit form from the WACISA CRAFT SHOP at 2202 North 67th Street.

All sales must be made on an appointment basis. The shop is open evenings and weekends and appointments may be made by calling 466-3284.

FALL POW WOW

The annual Fall Pow Wow of the Golden Sun Lodge will be held August 20-22nd. It will be held at Camp Minis Kuya at 1st and Van Dorn. Registration for all members will begin promptly at 1:30 p.m. Candidates will begin arriving at 2:30 p.m. so please plan to be on time.

The event fee for this year will be five dollars. This fee includes the payment of annual dues.
