COSTUME REQUIREMENTS

The second major event of the Golden Sun Lodge for 1966 is the Annual Fall Pow Wow. Scheduled to be held August 5th, 6th and 7th, the event has been moved to the Cornhusker Scout Reservation near Humboldt, Nebraska. The Lodge Executive Committee realizes that transportation may be a problem for some arrowmen. However we feel that car pools may be arranged in local area (see article later in this paper).

Arrowmen should be prepared to camp out for two nights (Friday and Saturday). Be sure and bring your uniform (scout) and your O.A. Sash with you.

This year no arrowmen will be allowed in the Candidate Camp area without a complete costume as outlined in the SUNDIAL.

At this year's Pow Wow the Brotherhood ceremony will be performed for all eligible Ordeal Members. An orientation session will be held for all Ordeal members and the new members. The annual election of Lodge and Chapter officers will be held.

The fee for this event is \$6.00. This fee includes the cost of food and the payment of next year's annual dues.

Ceremonial teams will be expected to report at 10:30 A.M., August 5th. Tribes men are expected to report at 1:00 P.M. and candidates will report at 1:30 the same day. **PLEASE BE PROMPT!!**

This year's Pow Wow will be well worth attending. I hope that a record number of Arrowmen will be present to support their Lodge.

As in past years all arrowmen who wish to take active parts in the PowWow ceremonies, whether it be as a senior sachem, a torchman, or as the leader of an Ordeal Workproject, must be in official Lodge costume. The following are the costume requirements accepted by the Lodge executive committee last year. They must be strictly followed so that a uniform Indian atmosphere may be obtained.

For Ordeal Members: Rectangular breech cloths which must be black in color with a gold border. The Lodge totem (a three inch, twelve pointed sun) must be worn in the lower right hand corner of the breech cloth. A personal totem, not larger than three inches may be worn in the upper left hand corner. Vests, which must also be black in color, can be worn. They must also have a gold border and can have beadwork on them, as long as it is plains Indian style. Hair roaches, feather roaches, and head dresses similar to this can be worn. Other items such as necklaces, bells and arm-bands also can be worn. And of course a swimming suit and moccasins, or black or brown shoes. **NO TENNIS SHOES.**

For Brotherhood Members: All of the above which an Ordeal Member may wear, plus a set of leggings. These must be of plain style and black with a gold border.

Ceremonial Parts: For the most part everyone taking part in the ceremonies will be expected to dress according to their rank, either Ordeal or Brotherhood. Only Senior Sachems, Senior Medicinemen, Vigil Members and the 4 speaking parts (Allowat Sakima, Meteu, Kichkinet and Nutiket) can wear feathered war bonnets.
