

NEW CIRCLE SITE SELECTED

Very recently the Tribal Council of the Golden Sun Lodge voted to select a new circle to replace the one at Minis Kuya. The move was necessary for several reasons. First, it was hard to keep an Indian atmosphere when planes roared overhead and cars whizzed down the highway. The circle is also too small, and from indications we would have to run four ceremonies at Minis Kuya. Therefore, we have selected and in turn have been given an area at the Cornhusker Scout Reservation. It will take a great deal of work to prepare the circle and therefore a sort of "temporary" one will be used this fall at the Reservation. Many plans are now being made for a permanent one at the Reservation, and the "blue-print" should be ready by the Pow Wow.

"III

The term of all officers, chapter and lodge shall be from January 1 to December 31st, and they shall be installed at the annual Winter Event, from the date of adjournment of the annual Pow Wow to the time their successors take office and the officers shall be installed as the concluding event of each fall Pow Wow."
