

## NEW AMENDMENTS TO RULES

The following will be voted on at the Winter Event. These are changes to the current Rules of the Golden Sun Lodge:

1. Add to Rule II the following:  
"D. All elections to Order of the Arrow membership shall be by either a chartered unit or by the Executive Committee (Tribal Council) of the Lodge, and by no other person or group." Endorsed by T.C.
2. Add to Rule II the following:  
"E. No calling out ceremony shall be conducted by any person or group unless authorized by the Executive Committee of the Lodge." Endorsed by the T.C.
3. In Rule V, A. strike out "3.00" and substitute "\$3.50" and add the following as part of Rule V, A.:  
"One Golden Sun Lodge pocket flap patch." Endorsed by the T.C.
4. Add the following to Rule III, C:  
"Before the Fall Pow Wow, the Executive Committee shall serve as a nominating committee. By a majority vote of the voting members present, it shall nominate at least one ~~10000~~ candidate for each lodge office. This slate of candidates shall be published before the Pow Wow and shall be presented as the Executive Committee's nominees at the time of the lodge elections. These nominations shall in no way prevent any voting member of the lodge from the floor at the time of the elections." Endorsed by the T.C.
5. Add the following to Rule VIII:  
"B. A copy of these official rules will be sent to all new members as soon as possible upon their induction." Endorsed by T.C.
6. Add the following to Rule VIII:  
"C. The Executive Committee, upon receipt of an amendment in accordance with this section, shall be responsible for seeing that the amendment is sent to all lodge members within the given time allowance." Endorsed by T.C.
7. Strike out the present Rule III, D and substitute the following:  
"The executive committee shall be composed of the four elected lodge

officers and the Chief of each chapter, each of which will have one vote. In the absence of the Chapter Chief, the Vice-Chief (or in his absence, the Chapter Secretary) will cast the Chapter's vote. In addition the past Lodge Chief, the Lodge operating committee chairmen, the Lodge Advisor, the Scout Executive and the Staff Advisor, the Chapter Advisors, a member of the Council Camping Committee, and all Vigil Honor members shall be invited in an advisory capacity." Endorsed by T.C.

8. Resolution "A" as printed in the last issue of the "Sundial" did not receive a favorable vote by the T.C.

## T.C. MEETING MINUTES

Meeting held Oct. 1, 1966--

In addition to the votes taken upon Rule changes the T.C. took the following actions:

1. Old business: A new design for the Lodge neckerchief was exhibited. It would cut the number of points to 12. This would save 12 cents. It was decided that we should maintain our present design.
2. Jerry Huggins (with Art May as Advisor) was appointed to organize the Lodge's dance team. A full rehearsal will take place at the Winter Event.
3. A point system was selected as the means of selecting the outstanding chapter. (See details elsewhere in this paper). This year the trophy will be awarded at the winter event-- next year at the Pow Wow. Each chapter is to send a summary of its activities since 1-1-'65 to the Lodge Chief.
4. December 3, 1966 was set as the Winter Event date. If we are able to find a place to prepare our own food the fee was set at \$1.50-- otherwise it will be \$2.00. \$10 was appropriated for cleaning up premises used for the event and up to \$25 may be spent for entertainment.
5. Minutes of last meeting were read and approved.
