ERNIE SIGLER SPEAKS AT WINTER EVENT

Nebraska Cornhusker football quarterback Ernie Sigler was the featured speaker at the Winter Event held on December 7, 1968.

Sigler spoke to about 115 arrowmen about what it meant to him to be in the Boy Scouts and in the OA, the leadership ability built in him by his experiences as a Boy Scout, and what we could do to make the Scout movement better.

NEW BROTHERHOOD REQUIREMENTS ADDED TO OLD

One Ordeal member was talking to another member, a Brotherhood member, and said that he was "finally a member of the OA".

Nodding, the Brotherhood member agreed, but added, "Ordeal is only the first step in becoming an Arrowman, Brotherhood is the completion in becoming an Arrowman".

To become a Brotherhood member you must:

- (a) Serve 10 months as an Ordeal member
- (b) Be actively registered as a Scout, and a member of the Lodge
- (c) Know the Order of the Arrow Obligation, Song, and be able to answer the questions on the Brotherhood questionnaire
- (d) Write a 100 to 200 word essay rededicating yourself to the principle of Cheerful Service
