

ANTICIPATION MOUNTS...AS  
NATIONAL CONFERENCE NEARS

The 54th Anniversary National Conference, August 23-26, 1969, is the high point of activity for OA members across the nation this year.

As many of you remember, a National Conference is a place to learn new and exciting concepts of the OA, rules and regulations, and to know the pride of being an Arrowman.

The Golden Sun Lodge was the host Lodge of the 53rd National Conference held on the University of Nebraska campus, August, 1967.

Tentative plans for our trip to the Conference have been set up by the Tribal Council and are subject to change.

We plan to leave Lincoln early Friday, August 22nd, and arrive in Springfield Illinois, take a tour of Lincoln's birthplace, and spend the night there.

Leaving Springfield the next morning, we will arrive in Bloomington Indiana, sight of Indiana University and the National Conference, that same day.

From August 23rd to the 26th, we will be at the Conference. Lodging and meals will be provided while we are at the Conference.

Stepping on the bus the 26th will mean saying good-bye to the University, and the new friends you made at the Conference. But you can look forward to staying at Peoria Illinois that night, and touring West Branch Iowa, where Herbert Hoover was born.

Total Conference fee, which provides your lodging and meals while at the Conference is apr. \$35.00.

The Tribal Council has adopted a fee of \$85.00 to attend the National Conference. This figure includes the Conference fee of \$35.00, transportation to and from the Conference, and your lodging to and from the Conference. You must provide your own meals in route to and from the Conference.

If you would like to attend the 1969 National Order of the Arrow Conference, send in a \$10.00 reservation fee to the Boy Scout Service Center, 412 Lincoln Center, Lincoln Nebraska.

Include with your money, your name, address, telephone number, rank, status in the OA, offices you have held in the OA, and unit number.

The Scout office must have your reservation fee and information in the office, by Monday, February 24, 1969 if you are to be considered to go with the Lodge's delegation.

Only a limited number can go, so hurry and get your reservation in, as some may not be able to go.

The \$10.00 is not refundable, but may be transferred to someone else's name. If your registration is not accepted, your money will be sent back to you.

Remember, the deadline for registration for the trip to the Conference is the 24th of February which is a Monday. The Scout office must have your money in the office by that time or you will not go!

This goes for every member in our Lodge, whether it be Lodge officer, Chapter officer, or Chapter member.

CEREMONIAL TRYOUTS

Tryouts for both the Ordeal, Brotherhood Ceremonial parts at the Fall Pow Wow will be held at the Spring Event.
