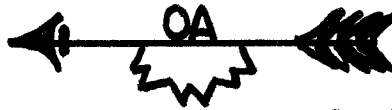

**MR. BREZINA RETIRES AFTER 51 YEARS WITH BOY SCOUTS:
WAS TAPPED INTO GOLDEN SUN IN 1944, VIGIL IN 1967**

After 51 years of service to the Boy Scouts, and adult leaders of the Cornhusker Council, Mr. Erv Brezina will retire this September.

Mr. Brezina recalls his start in Scouting with Troop 16 from Lincoln with a gleam in his eye.

1948 marked Mr. Brezina's first scouting experience. He remembers "the scoutmasters met at city hall.

He explained that this was the only type of organization the troops of this area had.

Mr. Brezina was tapped into the Golden Sun, the forerunner of the Golden Sun Lodge, Order of the Arrow, in 1944.

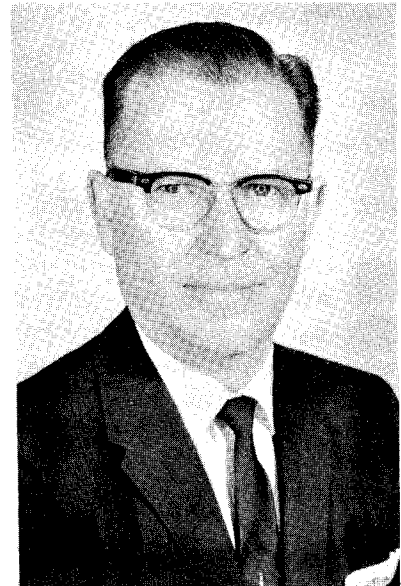
He received the Vigil Honor in the Order of the Arrow in 1967. The Vigil is the highest honor given to someone in the Order.

Looking back on the night that he received his Vigil, Mr. Brezina best remembers the cold weather that kept him shivering almost all

night.

The Vigil Honor was the most outstanding experience he has had in the Order of the Arrow, Mr. Brezina said.

"Although Mr. Brezina is retiring as a professional, several of the Antelope Valley District Committee members are trying to recruit his services for the committee," said Dave Van Horn, committee member.
