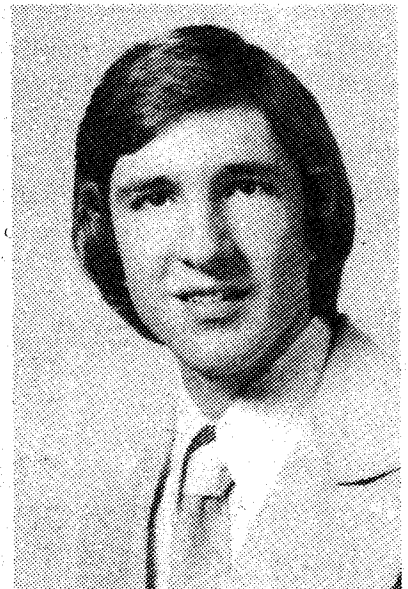


**ARROWMEN TO GATHER IN YORK FOR ANNUAL SECTION CONCLAVE**
