## TAP OUT CEREMONY ADDED TO ANNUAL O.A. POW WOW

Election information and report forms for 1975 have been sent to all unit leaders in the Cornhusker Council. Membership requirements and election procedures for the Order of the Arrow are clearly outlined from pages 48 to 64 in your Handbook and Arrowmen conducting unit elections will be going "by the book".

The "tapping-out" of elected candidates will change this year. Only candidates of units in camp at the Cornhusker Scout Reservation will be tapped at the traditional Thursday evening ceremonies. Candidates whose units do not attend the Council Camp this summer will be "tapped" at the opening ceremony of the Annual Pow Wow on August 1.

The change is expected to shorten the O.A. activities on Thursday evenings during camp and to eliminate the need for long hours, hard miles, and late nights for candidates who had to get to camp just to be "tapped-out". We anticipate, however, that most units will recognize the importance of being in camp and that "tap-outs" at the Pow Wow will be minimal.

Candidates for BROTHERHOOD will not have to wait until the Annual Pow Wow this year to be inducted. The Executive Committee took action at their November meeting to move the Brotherhood Ceremony to the Spring Event, May 30-June 1 at the Cornhusker Scout Reservation.
