## O.A. NATIONAL CONFERENCE

As a result of an "indication of interest" demonstrated at the National Conference in August, preliminary investigations have been made as to the feasibility of hosting the next National Conference in 1977 at the University of Nebraska - Lincoln Campus. Mr. R. Scott Agnew, Council Executive and Mr. R. Bruce Abernathy, Conference Coordinator met with Mr. Paul Moore of the National Headquarters, BSA to evaluate campus facilities. As a result of that meeting a formal invitation from the University of Nebraska and the Cornhusker Council Executive Board have been extended. At a special Executive Committee Meeting of the Golden Sun Lodge, a formal resolution offering to host the '77 National Conference was adopted, signed by each members of the Executive Committee and forwarded to National Headquarters. A decision relative to the final site selection will be made in December when the National Executive Committee of the Order of the Arrow is scheduled to meet.
