DON'T FORGET

Don't forget...when attending a Lodge event where you will be camping overnight, you must have at least a Class I medical form with you. This form does not require a doctor's signature, but does include a medical history as well as permission for treatment in the case of an emergency.

The Lodge will not keep the forms, but we do ask that you carry it with you during the event by keeping it in your rear pocket so it can be found if there is an emergency. We hope that your voluntary compliance with this request will prevent the need to gather these forms at event check-ins.
