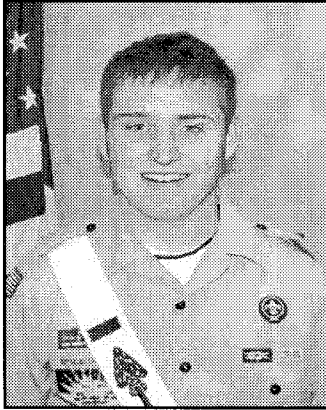


Meet Your Officers...
